





Screening of operators and drivers

Installation of additional warning systems (Lone worker device, one or two fixed panic buttons in the trucks)

Physical escort or guarding of trucks unable to reach a secure area

Creation of blacklisted areas (parking lots or places with a high theft rate) with no stop possible

External verification in the event of a police or customs check that these are official vehicles.
